Noxon Schools Extra/Co-Curricular Covid 19 Guidelines 2020-2021

To have spectators for our events, fans must follow these guidelines. The District appreciates your cooperation and asks that if you cannot comply, for whatever reason, that you do not attend. Spectators will be asked to leave if you do not comply with these guidelines to ensure everyone's safety. These guidelines will apply to all Junior High extra/co-curricular activities as well as High School. A family's role in maintaining safety guidelines for themselves and others is very important. Make sure your child and immediate household members are free from illness before participating in practice and competition (if there is doubt stay home). Provide personal items for your child and clearly label them.

1. Fans/Spectators Indoor events (50 spectators max)

- Face Coverings ARE REQUIRED
- (2) Guests Max per athlete or coach. Please notify the athletic director 2 days prior to an event the names of the two family guests that will be attending.* These names will be placed on a designated list. The guests must show ID with their names for admittance. Siblings are not recommended to attend, but special circumstances will be granted with approval from administration (special requests may be granted, requested 3 days prior to the event).
- Temperatures will be taken for all spectators, team members and officials.
- Keep 6ft social distances from non-family members Home fans (North) Visiting fans (South)

2. Fans/Spectators Outdoor events (100 spectators max)

- Face Coverings REQUIRED when moving around or less than 6ft distance
- RECOMMENDED when stationary or with more than 6ft distance
- (4) Guests Max per athlete or coach. Please notify the athletic director 2 days prior to an event the names of the four direct family guests that will be attending. These names will be placed on a designated list. The guests must show ID with their names for admittance. Siblings are not recommended to attend, but special circumstances will be granted with approval from administration (special requests may be granted, must be requested 3 days prior to the event).
- 6ft social distances will be marked -Home fans (South Bleachers) -Visiting fans (North Mini Bleachers)

3. Concessions

There will be no concessions sold at home events this Fall.

^{*}If athletes have dual parent households the parent should contact the athletic director for two additional tickets for the dual household.

4. Admission Fees

- There will not be admission fees for Fall. There will be a donation box to help offset the costs of hiring officials.

5. Online Broadcasts

- Noxon High School is working on having cameras installed to broadcast indoor and outdoor games on the NFHS Network. The cameras should be installed during the first two months of school.

6. Practice Guidelines

- Personal water bottles/equipment
- Sanitize everything used (Locker rooms, bleachers, equipment)
- Masks optional when performing physical activity
- Temperature checks required for before school and non-school day practices.

7. <u>Transportation (Travel)</u>

- Temp checks before (100.4 max) by coach
- Seating Charts, sitting every other seat -Team personnel only
- Face Coverings MANDATORY within counties that have 4 or more active cases.
- Stops will be limited when traveling, please bring your own water and healthy snacks.

8. Team/Club Members (Bench/Sideline)

- Face Covering mandatory -3ft minimum social Distancing Team boxes extended
- Personal items separated -Cleaned and sanitized before/after use

9. Temperature/Screening Protocols

- Administered by Coach/Advisor -100.4 Max (3 temp check attempts max)
- If over 100.4
 - 1. Isolated from activity/Personnel
 - 2. Parent notified, arrange alternative travel
 - 3. Must be fever free for 72 hours before returning.
